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### ***Anne Hardy - Feelings***

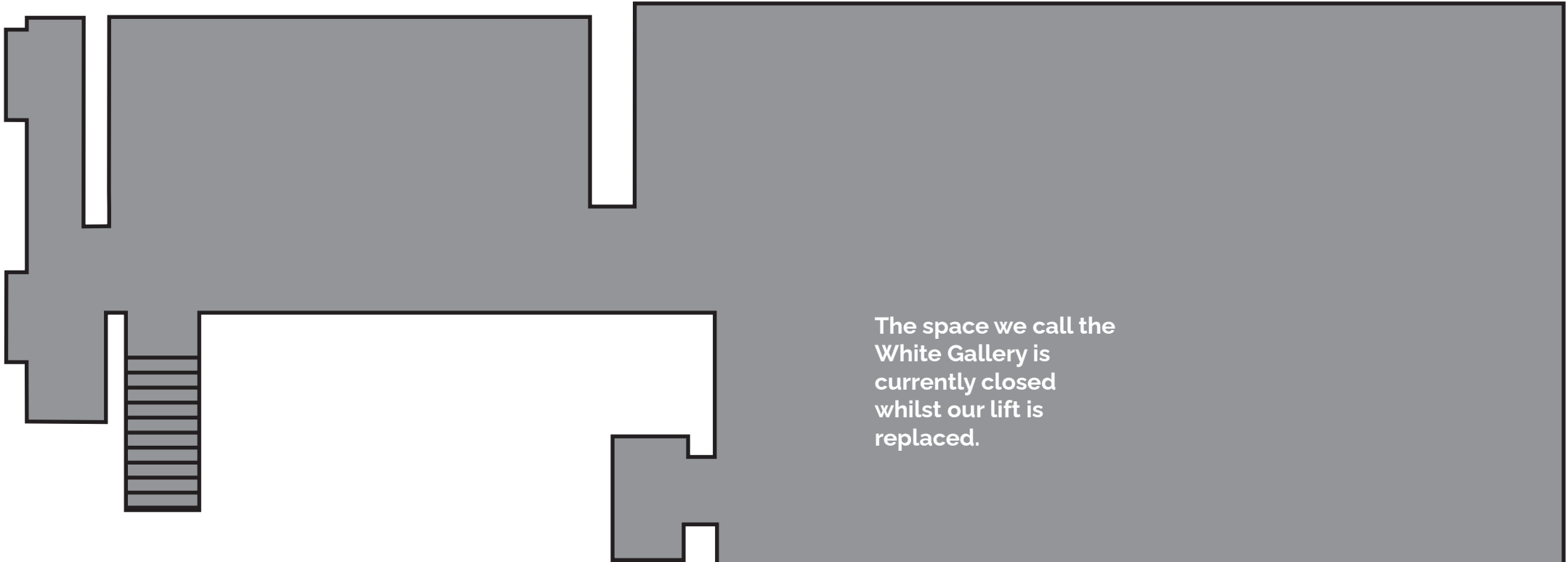
*Feelings* is an exhibition of sound, sculpture, and light installations presented across the Georgian Gallery and Georgian Gallery Balcony. These spaces are dimly lit, including flickering light sculptures that fluctuate in brightness. Sound is present throughout the exhibition via four speakers.

Seating is available in selected areas of the gallery. Visitors are asked not to touch the artworks unless otherwise indicated. If you require any additional access support or sensory resources during your visit, please speak to one of our Volunteer Exhibition Assistants at the Welcome Desk, who will be happy to help.

# Level 2 Welcome Desk

The **Welcome Desk** is located on Level 2 when taking the stairs from Level 0. You will be greeted by one of our Volunteers at our **Welcome Desk**, where you can also find exhibition guides, portable chairs, and ask them for any further information.

You will also find our hallway where our **Toilets** and **Gallery Shop** are located. It is a brightly lit space and can have groups of people waiting in it. The chair lift is also located here, which can take you up to the **Georgian Gallery**.

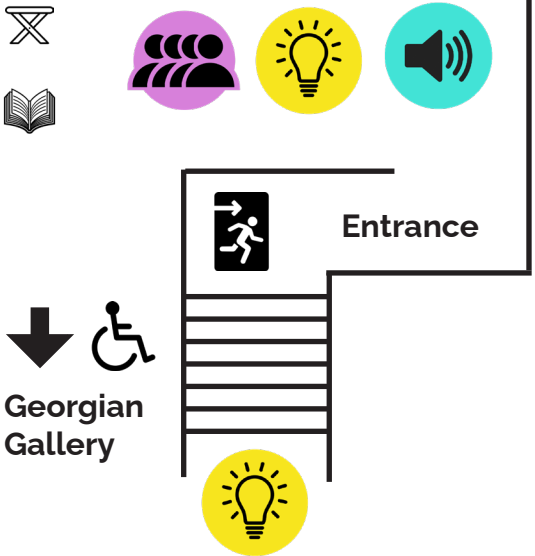

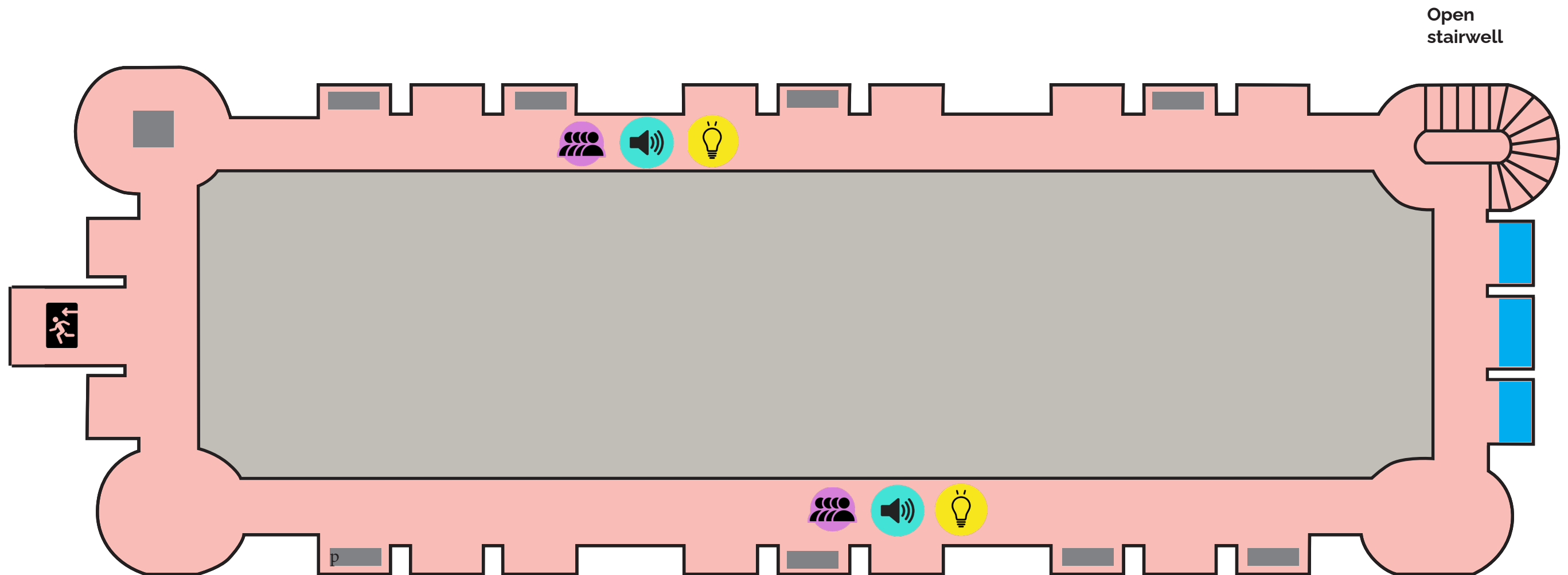

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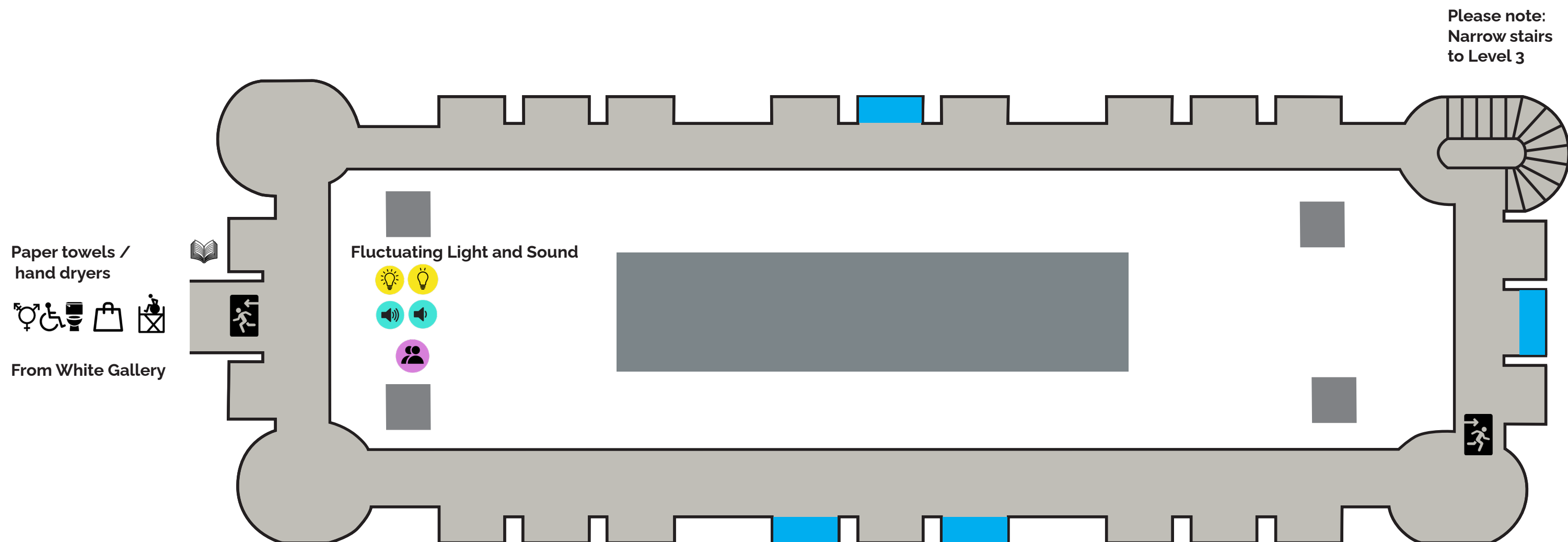
## Level 3 Georgian Gallery Balcony



The **Georgian Gallery Balcony** overlooks the Georgian Gallery on Level 3. It has a narrow passageway with a width of 1.94m (from the wall to the railing). Running along the balcony walls are sculptures by artist Anne Hardy.

# Level 2 Georgian Gallery



You can enter our **Georgian Gallery** at the end of the corridor past the Toilets and Gallery Shop on Level 2. There are five steps up to this gallery and we have a chair lift available for wheelchair users. Please speak to a Volunteer if you require the chair lift. Please note that a wheelchair is available on request at the gallery.

The **Georgian Gallery** contains a large sculptural installation positioned in the centre of the gallery floor. Four speakers are located in the corners of the room. Above the sculpture, nine suspended light elements run through the centre of the gallery space. **Both the sound and light levels vary throughout the exhibition and may change during your visit.**

In the back left corner of the Georgian Gallery there is a spiral staircase (22 steps in total) leading up to the **Georgian Gallery Balcony** on Level 3.
